#### **Title**

Smile Design: Essential Principles, Digital Tools, Techniques and Applications

#### **Abstract**

The aim of the lecture is to perform a proper examination of the aesthetic parameters and tools available to the practitioner today for the planning of highly aesthetic cases. There are several methods for an aesthetic analysis of our patients, with advantages and disadvantages, different learning curves, but above all different predictability. The integration of this tool within the prosthetic treatment plan is fundamental in two stages, the first being the motivation and alignment of the patient's expectations with the actual therapeutic possibilities, and the second is to provide guidance in the interdisciplinary collaboration and with the dental technician for the realization of the case while minimizing the aesthetic try in.
