Title

Orthognathic Surgery and Facial Injectables as a Part of the Holistic Approach to the Gummy Smile

Abstract

Excessive gingival display is mainly caused by hypermobility of the upper lip, altered passive eruption, gingival hyperplasia, and bony maxillary vertical excess. Orthognathic surgery is the optimal treatment option for patients with moderate and severe vertical maxillary excess. Therefore, Le Fort 1 osteotomy may be performed in conjunction with possible further mandibular osteotomies and chin repositioning has to be considered.

On the other hand Botulinum toxin injections are considered an alternative treatment to extensive surgical procedures for moderate or severe gummy smile. Botulinum is injected in the alar fossa, at the intersection of three muscles called the Yonsei Point.

Combining muscle-relaxing injections and dermal fillers can improve the appearance of a gummy smile since fillers can then be injected into the upper lip to help increase its thickness and improve the upper gingival display.

Over the last several years he has been practicing in facial aesthetics and facial injectables (Botox, Hyaluronic Acid, Threads, Blood Derivatives). He is also the head trainer of the Australasian Academy of Dento-Facial Aesthetics in Europe, focusing on training doctors to incorporate facial injectable treatments into their daily clinical practice.
