Title

Excessive Gingival Display Smile: Diagnosis and Current Periodontal Treatment Concepts

Abstract

Management of excessive gingival display or "gummy smile" patients very often requires the collaboration of specialists from different aspects of dentistry in order to achieve a maximum esthetic result. The most important part of this multidisciplinary approach is the initial esthetic analysis of each individual case and the establishment of the appropriate individualized treatment plan.

Periodontists are asked to participate in the treatment of the aforementioned cases and in their armamentarium are available different treatment options based on the etiology of each particular case. In this presentation a simple and easy to follow classification of the excessive gingival display will be presented, in order to help clinicians to select the appropriate treatment plan. In addition, the surgical steps will be explained through the analysis of clinical cases, as well as potential complications will be discussed.

His private practice is limited to Periodontics and Implants and is located in Athens, Greece.
