Becoming a Better Leader through Executive Leadership Coaching

Abstract

Members of the largest generation are retiring, leaving voids in leadership at the top. Furthermore, as the complexity of the work environment increases more leaders are engaging coaches to help them manage difficult challenges. Executive leadership coaching is a personalized professional development process with the goal of enhancing leadership skills and behaviors to have a positive impact on business. Coaching empowers leaders to set goals and proactively manage their careers to prepare for future roles and opportunities. This presentation will focus on what executive leadership coaching is, the benefits of coaching, an overview of the coaching process and how to identify a coach that is a good fit. By identifying what is most important to the client, they become more self-aware and learn to use tools to make positive changes in their lives, their organizations and their communities.

Dr. Lefebvre served as Editor-in-Chief for The Journal of Prosthetic Dentistry (JPD) for nine years and is currently Chair-Elect of the Editorial Council for the JPD. Dr. Lefebvre is a 2005-2006 fellow of the Hedwig van Ameringen Executive Leadership in Academic Medicine (ELAM) program and a Certified Executive Leadership Coach through the University of Georgia. She is an advisor for the ELAM and ADEA Leadership Institute programs. In addition, she serves as an Executive Leadership Coach for the ELAM program. Dr. Lefebvre is the Chair of the Academy of Prosthodontics Foundation and was the recipient of the Academy's 2024 Distinguished Service Award.
